

Maths Mosaic Competition

Can you design a mosaic pattern that reflects the Europa School values?



This competition, launched in Math's Week , is the start of an exciting year long project in which we aim to replace some of the older pieces of art around the school with vibrant mosaics.

We would like the mosaics to be designed by the children. The theme is the 'Europa School Values' interpreted through mathematical patterns. These could be patterns such as repeated images, tessellating images, images that increase in size.

The competition is open to all primary children. Your child may have completed an entry in the class as part of 'Maths Week'. However they are welcome to submit a second entry done at home.

Designs must be done on a sheet of A4 squared paper. Each square must use only one colour. The entry must be labelled with the full name of the child and their class and must be returned by Tuesday 2nd of July.
