<p>Bug club</p> 	<p>There is a big selection of books online in Bug Club. The password is at the front of the yellow reading record. At the end of each book there is a fun online quiz.</p>
<p>Spelling & tricky words</p>	<p>You may want to play bingo or snap games during the year to help ensure your child is really confident in recognising and spelling the key words overleaf.</p> 
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Number bonds to 20 at speed (e.g. $13 + 7/20 - 8$) these basic number facts help throughout future mental maths calculations all the way up the school (see bonds overleaf).</p> <p>Real world maths: Please involve your child with your use of maths in daily life - selecting coins from your purse, weighing out ingredients for cooking. The more they understand the value of numbers in real life, the more they will be motivated to learn.</p>
